The main focus of the journal, as its name implies, is South Central Africa; but inaugural lectures and articles of a more general interest will also be published. A series of monograph supplements to *Zambezia* is also provided to cover the main disciplines in the University (Agriculture, Commerce and Law, Education, Engineering, Humanities, Medicine, Science and Social Studies); and this series will not necessarily have the same regional focus as *Zambezia* itself. Ten such supplements have appeared so far; those for 1980 will be on Deforestation, European Education, and an Education Supplement.
